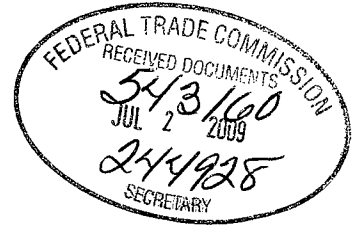

The proposed consent agreement has been executed by Complaint Counsel and Respondents and has been approved by the Director of the Bureau of Consumer Protection. The proposed consent agreement, which conforms to the requirements of Commission Rule of Practice 2.32, is attached to this motion. The proposed consent agreement, if accepted by the Commission, would resolve this matter in its entirety.

The parties respectfully request that the Secretary, pursuant to Rule 3.25(c), enter the attached order withdrawing this matter from adjudication and staying all proceedings before the Administrative Law Judge pending a determination by the Commission with respect to the proposed consent agreement. Pursuant to Rule 3.25(b), the parties further request that the proposed consent agreement not be placed on the public record unless and until it is accepted by

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
